PROF. V. APTOWITZER

The death took place in Jerusalem yesterday at the age of 72 of Professor Aptowitzer, noted Jewish scholar and authority on theological philosophy.

Professor Aptowitzer, who was at one time Professor of Jewish Theology at Vienna University, published a number of books on Talmudical and Rabbinical literature.

The funeral will leave at 11 o'clock from 9 Maimon Road.

LECTURER DIES ON PLATFORM

YESHAYAHU KARNIEL

HAIFA, Saturday. — While lecturing on Eliezer Ben-Yehuda (on the anniversary of the great Hebrew lexicographer's death), at the Technical Institute here this afternoon, Mr. Yeshayahu Karniel (Azmaveth) collapsed suddenly and died shortly afterwards. He was 62.

Beginning his talk, Mr. Karniel had told his audience that he was not feeling well, but that he hoped to be able to finish his address. About 30 minutes later he collapsed.

Mr. Karniel, who was a popular speaker as well as writer in the satirical vein, frequently spoke over the P.B.S., and was at one time editor of the "Doar Hayom," a Hebrew daily which appeared in Jerusalem several years ago.

He was at various times on the staff of the Anglo-Palestine Bank in Jaffa, Haifa, Tiberias and Safad.

He leaves his wife, three sons and two daughters,
